# ELECTION RESULTS

After the polls close on Election Day, & once early voting & vote-by-mail results are uploaded, Election Day site totals will also begin to upload to the Lake County Clerk's Election Results portal. To access the Election Results portal, please visit [bit.ly/LC-ERP](https://bit.ly/LC-ERP).



Per Illinois election law, election results are not final until 14 days after Election Day. There may be votes that need to be counted from verified provisional ballots & late-arriving vote-by-mail ballots postmarked no later than Election Day.



## From the Assessor

### 2023 Property Tax Bills

2023 Property Tax Bills (payable 2024) are currently being worked on by multiple departments in the Treasurer's Department. During this time, the function to view them will not be available on the Treasurer's website. The ability to pull up a tax bill will be restored on May 1st when the numbers are final. In the meantime, please email inquiries to [treasurer@lakecountyil.gov](mailto:treasurer@lakecountyil.gov). 2023 Property Tax Bills will be mailed out May 1st. The 1st installment due date is June 5th. The 2nd installment due date is September 5th. For any questions about paying your bill, please call the Lake County Treasurer at 847-377-2323.

When you do receive your tax bill, check the right-hand side of the bill to make sure you are getting all the exemptions you are entitled to. **Please note beginning in the 2023 tax year, General and Senior Homestead Exemptions will be increased to an \$8,000 assessed value reduction, each.**

A retirement ceremony for Sheriff's K9 Dax was this morning at the Sheriff's Patrol Division in Libertyville to congratulate him on his ten years of dedicated service.

K9 Dax, who joined the Lake County Sheriff's Office in Spring 2015, has thrived in his role as a police canine. K9 Dax and his partner, Deputy John Forlenza, have located over 400 missing endangered people or fleeing felons. He has hundreds of kilos of illegal drugs, millions of dollars seized, dozens of firearms discarded by offenders, dozens of seized vehicles, and has participated in hundreds of community and school demonstrations.
