





2023 Property Tax Bills

2023 Property Tax Bills have been mailed out. The 1st installment due date is June 5th. The 2nd installment due date is September 5th. For any questions about paying your bill, please call the Lake County Treasurer at 847-377-2323 or email inquiries to <u>treasurer@lakecountyil.gov.</u>

When you do receive your tax bill, make sure you check the right-hand side of the bill to make sure you are getting all of the exemptions you are entitled to. *If you see an error, please let us know immediately so we can help you correct it.* All applications must be submitted online through the Lake County Smartfile E-Filing Portal. (Click on the button below,) This system allows you to electronically file most applications related to your property's assessment, and to change your mailing address. If you need help creating an account or logging in, please contact the Chief County Assessment Office at assessor@lakecountyil.gov or (847) 377-2050.

Lyme Disease Awareness Month

Ticks are most active during warmer months. Ticks may be small in size, but we still need to protect ourselves, our families, and our pets against the diseases they can carry, especially

<u>Lyme disease</u> is spread through the bite of infected ticks. In most cases, the ticks that are attached 36 hours or more may transmit infection. The most common symptom of Lyme disease is the bullseye rash. Other symptoms can include fever, headache & fatigue.



Steps you can take to prevent Lyme disease include:

- Dress: Wear long sleeves, pants & closed toe shoes when outdoors to cover your skin
- Defend: Use insect repellent when outdoors & avoid tick habitats
- Check: Check your entire body for ticks after being outdoors, including your children & pets
- Remove: Use fine-tipped tweezers to promptly remove ticks

Skin Cancer Awareness Month

May is Skin Cancer Awareness Month, which aims to educate and raise awareness of the most common type of cancer in the United States. To lower your skin cancer risk, protect your skin from the sun & avoid indoor tanning. Sun protection is important all year round; even if it's cool & cloudy, you still need protection. UV rays, not temperature, do the damage.



Protect your skin when outdoors by:

- Staying in the shade, especially late morning through mid-afternoon.
- Wear a lightweight long-sleeved shirt or cover-up.
- Wear & reapply sunscreen at least every 2 hours.

Early detection is also key— make sure to perform regular <u>skin self-exams</u> and schedule an annual appointment with your dermatologist to get checked for skin cancer. Visit the <u>CDC</u> for more information about skin cancer.

TRANSPORTATION UPDATES

Washington Street to Close for Intersection Realignment

Fox Lake, IL - the Lake County division of Transportation (LCDOT) has closed Washington Street to through traffic on April 29th for the IL 59 and Grand Avenue Intersection Improvement Project.

The road will remain closed to through traffic for the duration of the project. Anticipated reopening - Spring of 2025

Detour Route: IL 59 to Devlin Road to Rollins Road. Local traffic will be allowed from north and south. The work zone will be closed to all traffic.

Public Meeting: Fairfield Road Planning Study

The Lake County Division of Transportation (LCDOT) is hosting a public meeting to provide preliminary details on the Fairfield Road Planning Study which evaluates the Fairfield Road corridor from Oakwood Drive in Round Lake Beach to Gilmer Road in Wauconda for potential roadway, intersection & non-motorized improvements. Exhibits & project team members will be available to discuss the study & answer questions. LCDOT encourages the public to provide feedback on the project. Public comments can be made in writing during the meeting. From 5/16 - 6/16, public comments can be sent by email & through the online comment form at *fairfieldroadstudy.com* for public record.



Lake County's PASSAGE Highway Advisory Radio Station Signed Off on May 1

The Lake County Division of Transportation's (LCDOT) real-time PASSAGE Highway Travel Advisory Radio Station, WQBR256 operating on 1620 AM, was decommissioned on May 1st, following nearly 20 years of broadcasting. The radio station was an essential part of Lake County PASSAGE when it opened in 2006. LCDOT operated & maintained 5 radio towers, which was nearing the end of their service life. After analysis of existing technology & careful consideration by the LCDOT traffic department, the existing towers were decommissioned. LCDOT is no longer be broadcasting on 1620 AM. Lake County will save about \$400,000 by decommissioning the radio towers in place of constructing new or updating the existing radio towers. LCDOT will maintain its focus on providing up-to-date information via Lake County PASSAGE which is available through its <u>Apple</u> and <u>Android</u> apps & at the website: <u>lakecountypassage.com</u>, provides real-time information in Lake County. The public can view snapshots from intersection cameras & snowplows, see road construction zones & closures, and even sign up for notifications to receive alerts for designated roadways. For those that still want to listen to the updates, LCDOT added a new feature to the PASSAGE website & apps so people can listen to the latest traffic into "radio-style"
