Snow Removal Operations

The Grant Township Highway Department plows snow after a 2" or more snowfall or when freezing temperatures indicate that the snow will not melt.



Please do not shovel or blow snow back into the street after it has been plowed and salted. Snow that is deposited on the street can freeze and cause hazardous conditions for you or your neighbors.

Be cautious when piling high mounds of snow at the entrance of your driveway that may cause visibility when backing out of your driveway, as well as children hiding behind the pile of snow where a snowplow driver may not see them.

When it starts to snow park your vehicle off the street. This protects it from being plowed in. Parked vehicles on a Township maintained road may be towed with the owner being responsible for the related costs.

If there is a fire hydrant in front of your home, clear the snow around it from the roadway. Don't forget your mail carrier when it comes to clearing an area in front of your mailbox.

Please place garbage and recycling bins on the apron of the driveway. These bins are not to be placed on the roadway as they become hazards for plow drivers.

To prevent damage to vehicles and snowplows, please remove all decorative rocks, logs or other objects located within the right of way.

Along with a New Year comes some New Laws!

January 1st is here and along with a New Year, are a whole lot of new laws going into effect on January 1st, 2025. The complete list can be found here: [**bills-taking-effect-2025.pdf**](#)



Of particular interest to me is **SB 3455, also known as Public Act 103-1002**. This bill requires the Illinois Department of Revenue to conduct a Property Tax study to evaluate Illinois' property tax system. This law "provides that the Department may also determine whether the existing property tax levy, assessment, appeal and collection process is reasonable and fair and may issue recommendations to improve that process." The Department shall complete and submit the final report under this Section to the Governor & the General Assembly by July 1, 2026. The full text of this bill can be found here: [**103-1002**](#)

I have already reached out the Chief County Assessment Office in Waukegan to see how the Lake County Township Assessors can help in this process. I truly hope this is going to be an avenue that welcomes opinions and thorough and thoughtful discussion on how to fix some of the problems with our state property tax system.

On Wednesday, December 11, 2024, Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker issued an Executive Order ordering legislators to examine ways to make housing more affordable for working-class residents. The order creates an Illinois Director of Housing Solutions, who will oversee the exploration of "how Illinois can accelerate plans to expand the supply and access of housing for working families," according to the Governor's Office. Nearly one third of Illinois households spend more than 30% of their income on housing, according to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. "If we are going to build on this state's record of growth and prosperity, lower costs for Illinois' working families, and be a state that everyone can call home, we must build more housing in every Illinois community from Cairo to Chicago," said Pritzker. "This announcement is just the beginning of some of the most important work we will do over the next few years—work that, if successful, can lower costs for thousands of families and lay the groundwork for decades of sustainable economic growth." The order was informed by a report by the Ad-Hoc Missing Middle Housing Solutions Advisory Committee, which proposed a series of interventions the State could pursue to accelerate the production of housing for middle-to-moderate income households. This is a lot of information, I know. I try to stay up to date on all of it. The bottom line is that the housing forecast for 2025 looks stable. No huge property value increases. No dramatic drops. Mortgage interest rates are predicted by Fannie Mae, MBA and Wells Fargo to drop from around 6.67% in Q1 to 6.33% in Q4. The biggest hurdles out there are for renters and first-time homebuyers. I'm hopeful about this new executive order and I look forward to reading more about it.

ACCESS PILOT PROGRAM

The RTA, Metra, and Cook County are partnering to extend reduced fares to Metra riders experiencing low incomes regionwide through the Access Pilot Program. Beginning January 16, 2024, all recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, or SNAP, living in the counties of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry, and Will are eligible to apply for more affordable transit at [GetAccess.org](https://www.getaccess.org). The program will run from Feb. 1, 2024 to July 31, 2025.

The Access Pilot Program is an 18-month expansion of the RTA's current **Ride Free and Reduced Fare** programs, which will continue to be available to older adults and individuals with disabilities.

Who is eligible?

Beginning Feb. 1, 2024, and running for 18 months, the Access Pilot Program will be available to anyone living in a household in the RTA region (Cook, DuPage, Lake, Kane, McHenry, and Will counties) who qualifies for the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program, or SNAP. SNAP is targeted to households with low income (165% of poverty level). Learn more about [SNAP eligibility](#) in Illinois.

Lake County's Snow Plow Routes

The snow will soon be falling again, and that means snow plows will be driving the roads to help clear the snow and ice and keep the roads safe. Just because you're driving across Lake County, remember that doesn't mean that every road is cleared by the Lake County Division of Transportation (LCDOT).

Our incredible crew at LCDOT provides 24/7 snow and ice response on 26 plow routes marked on blue [on this map](#), covering nearly 840 County highway lane miles. Everything else is plowed by the State, township or local municipality.

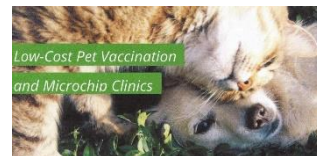

Christmas Tree Recycling & Disposal

Lake County Forest Preserves: Give your tree a 2nd life in your forest preserves by recycling your real, undecorated tree, you help create wood chips for trails and landscaping that enhance the preserves. Drop off your tree at 1 of 8 marked sites across Lake County, daily from 6:30am to sunset until February 1st. No yard waste or commercial drop-offs are accepted. Locations: Grant Woods in Ingleside, Green Belt in North Chicago, Half Day in Vernon Hills, Heron Creek in Long Grove, Lakewood in Wauconda (new location S of Ivanhoe Rd. near Heron Pond, Old School in Mettawa, Ryerson Conservation Area in Riverwoods and Van Patten Woods in Wadsworth. Facts: The Lake County Forest Preserves has been accepting trees for recycling for at least 20 years. Most years more than 1,000 trees are donated. The majority of the trees are mulched for use on trails. Some trees are used to create "fish cribs". Staff ties several trees together and sinks them with a cinderblock in larger lakes, particularly those that were formerly gravel quarries and lack substantial underwater vegetation. These lakes benefit from the fish cribs, as they serve as crucial habitats for fish.

Village of Fox Lake: Christmas trees (w/o decorations or lights) can be placed out for regular trash collection on your scheduled pick up days now through January 15th for complimentary disposal by Waste Management.

Village of Lakemoor: Bring your bare tree to the Public Works Building - 333 Wegner Rd, Lakemoor up through January 31st.

Village of Volo: Groot will offer FREE Christmas Tree pick-up for Volo residents on the first 3 pick-up days in January. These dates will be 1/6, 1/13, and 1/20 this year. All lights and ornaments must be removed from trees before they are placed at the curb.

Unincorporated Lake County: Those that have Groot - they will pick up trees (without any decorations, lights, etc.) during normal garbage pickup from 1/1 - 1/25. If tree is over 6', it must be cut down in size for pickup

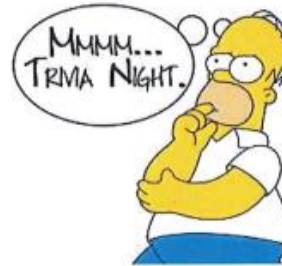

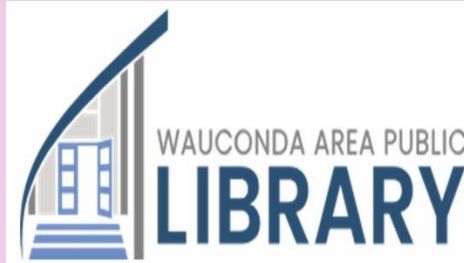

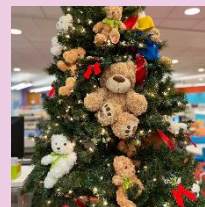

Individuals can call or text 988 if they are having thoughts of suicide or self-harm, worried about their safety or someone else, or worried about drug or alcohol misuse.



988 provides a connection to free, 24/7 confidential support.

988 Call specialists are trained in suicide prevention and crisis intervention.



In 2023, suicide claimed the lives of 83 Lake County residents. Suicide is preventable. Evidence shows that providing support services, talking about suicide, reducing access to means of self-harm and following up with loved ones are actions we can all take to help others. The Health Department offers [Mental Health First Aid training](#), teaching people how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illnesses and substance use disorders.

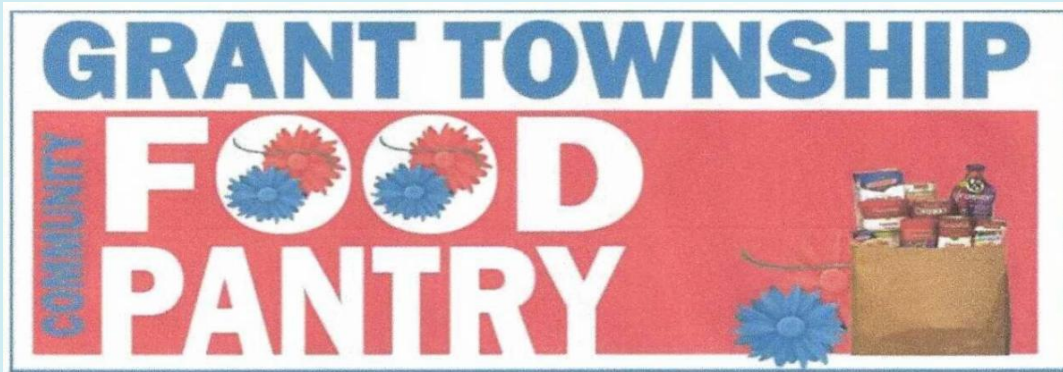

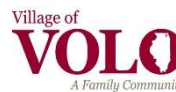
