4. Discuss Pending Litigation

There is a lawsuit between two residents, Shields v. Schuele. The lawsuit is about drainage from one property to another and who and/or what is to blame for the drainage and a hole that has been created by water flow. Shields has now included Grant Township as a part of the lawsuit, claiming that the township was responsible for the digging. It is difficult to track the changes in the property over the years and determine when and how the problem may have been created.
